ATHLETES' LICENSES

Pentathletes without confirmation from their NF of their ability to ride can compete in Nordic Open Championships in 4 disciplines apart from riding. Athletes wanting to participate in 4 disciplines without riding are very welcome to take part.

In addition the Jury will have the authority to eliminate a rider during warming up, should it become evident that the rider is not in possession of proper riding skills.

TRAINING

The competition venue is located on the coast with grass surface and terrain in the immediate vicinity. Training at the shooting range can take place from the time of arrival as it will be located close to the accommodations. As well, training will be possible before and after the riding event on Saturday 6 SEP, TBC.

EQUIPMENT CONTROL

The equipment control for fencing, see programme. Shooting: Before warm-up at shooting range.

TRANSPORTATION PLAN

Transportation from the airport to the competition venue (30 km distance) will be arranged upon request and clear indication of arrival times not later than 1 week prior to the competition. Transportation from the competition venue will be arranged after necessity.

INSURANCE

All members of the attending Delegations must insure themselves in case of accidental injury or illness. The organiser will not accept any responsibility financial or otherwise for loss, injury or illness of any Delegation member.

PISTOLS

It is suggested to place the IR shooting devices in checked luggage. No customs check necessary.

GENERAL INFORMATION

All athletes are kindly requested to wear their official national uniform at the competition. Please also bring a CD of your national anthem and a national flag.

Please contact directly the LOC to request accommodation for family and friends wishing to attend the competition.

Altitude / Weather conditions: Sea level and average temperature beginning September: 16-17 degrees C. We can have very fine days in September, of course with no guarantee.
